Our lads had a great win against Kenmare Shamrocks in round 1 before losing close games to Spa and Dingle. However it was enough to ensure that Na Gaeil maintained its Senior status for 2023.

Then in September our lads made their debut in the Senior County Championship. Again we were very competitive losing narrowly to both Austin Stacks and Mid Kerry before a well-deserved win against West Kerry in Gallarus. Roll on 2023!
